

CHENILLE FABRIC CARE

Regular Care

Protect from direct sunlight.

Vacuum routinely with a soft brush attachment to remove dust and debris. Use low suction to avoid damage to the fabric.

Keep at least 30cm away from direct heat sources.

Cleaning

Remove liquid spills immediately by blotting with a clean dry cloth or paper towel.

Do not rub.

Do not remove cushion covers for cleaning, even when zippers are present.

Shampoo clean using upholstery shampoo.

Do not use dishwashing or laundry detergents.

Do not wet cushion fillings or scrub with a stiff brush.

Gently vacuum to restore pile.

Dry in shade away from direct heat.

Allow to dry thoroughly before use.

Hot water extraction and dry cleaning can be used but it is strongly recommended that a professional cleaner be used for these methods.

Spot Cleaning

Clean as above. Dry cleaning solvent may be used with care, ensuring fabric and filling is not saturated.

For difficult to remove marks seek professional advice to avoid damaging fabric.

Pilling

This may occur as a result of regular use. It is not a fault and can be carefully removed with a battery operated fabric de-pilling shaver.

Shading

Shading may result following disruption of the orientation of pile fibres, for example after being sat on. Shading is a characteristic of the fabric and should not be considered a fault.
